

# Half-Square Triangles (HST)

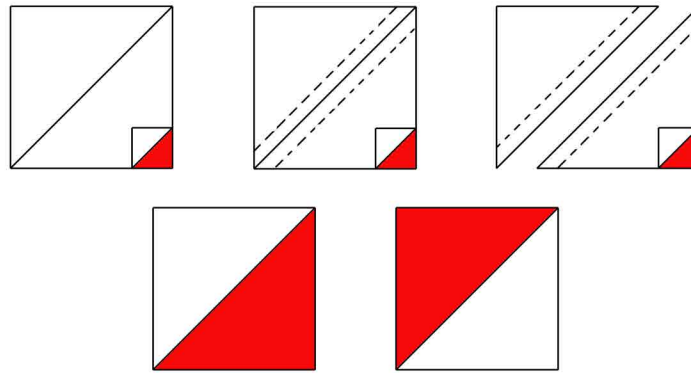


Diagram I

Start with two squares.

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the lightest of the 2 fabrics.

Place on other square, right sides together.

Sew  $1/4$ " from the drawn line, this is where a  $1/4$ " patchwork foot is really handy.

Sew  $1/4$ " on other side of line.

Cut along the drawn line.

Press toward the darker fabric.

You will have 2 half-square triangles (HST) when you are done.

I like to clip my little corners off.

# Flying Geese

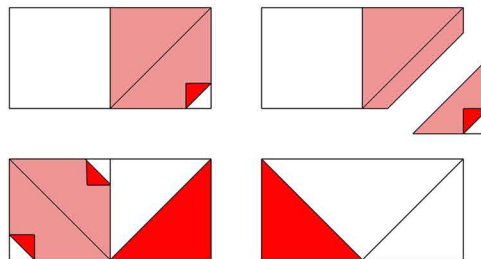


Diagram II

Start with 2 squares and one rectangle.

Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of both squares.

Place square on one end of the rectangle, right sides together.

Stitch ON THE DRAWN LINE.

Cut  $1/4$ " away from stitching and discard those little corners.

Press toward the corner triangle.

Repeat on opposite side to make 1 flying goose.
