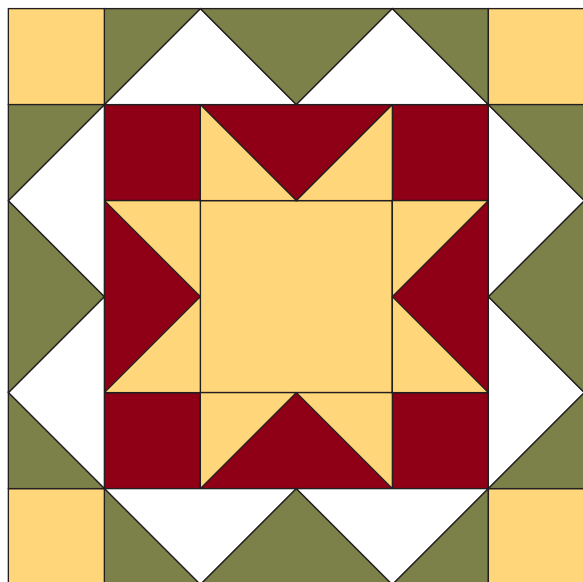


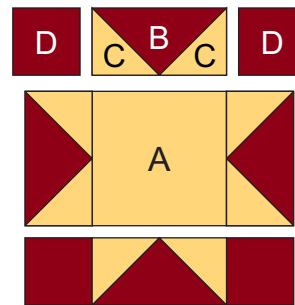
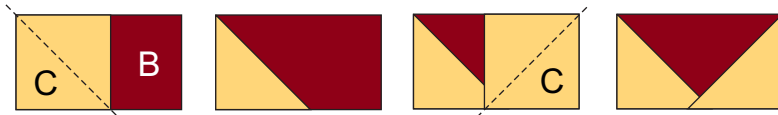
# Jingle Pieced Block Three



Piece Size	#	Notes
<b>Yellow Fabric</b>		
A 3-1/2"	1	Square
C 2"	12	Squares
<b>Red Fabric</b>		
B 2 x 3-1/2"	4	Rectangles
C 2"	4	Squares
<b>Green Fabric*</b>		
D 2-3/8"	4	Square, cut diag. into 8 HS Tri's
E 4-1/4"	1	Square, cross-cut into 4 QS Tri's
<b>Cream Fabric*</b>		
E 4-1/4"	2	Square, cross-cut into 8 QS Tri's

## Sawtooth Star

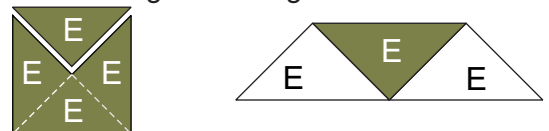
Place a yellow 2" square (C) on each red 2 x 3-1/2" rectangle (B). Sew diagonally through the square, then trim excess. Press to the red triangle. Repeat on the other side of the rectangle. Make four units.



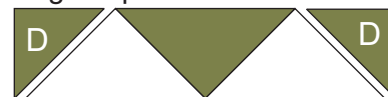
Sew a Flying Geese unit to opposite sides of the center yellow 3-1/2" square (A). Add a red 2" square (C) to the ends of remaining two Flying Geese units. Join to top and bottom of block to complete the 6" Sawtooth Star.

## Block Outer Border

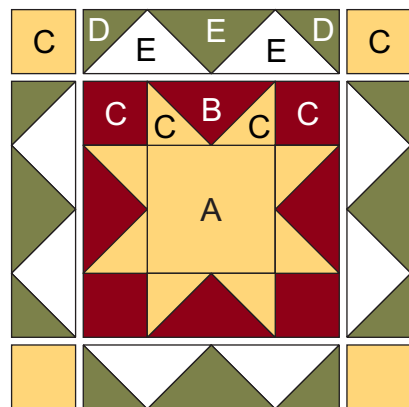
Sew two of the white quarter-square triangles (QS Tri's) (E) to short edges of a green QS Tri (E). Press toward the green triangles.



Attach a green HS Tri (D) to each side, the strip should now measure, 2 x 6-1/2". Or, use the paper piecing template below.



Sew a border unit to opposite sides of the center block. Attach a yellow 2" square to each end of the remaining two strips and sew to the top and bottom to complete the block!



\*Paper Piecing Pattern  
If paper piecing, you don't need to cut the green nor cream fabrics.
