



**Home Again Finishing Directions**  
(7" Block version)

This version uses 24 blocks that finish at 4" for the second border. I have included 4-patches for illustration purposes. I have not included directions for these blocks. Please use your favorite 4" block.

**Dark Aqua Print (1 1/2 yards\*)**

- 2 strips 1 1/2" x 18 1/2" for side border 1
- 2 strips 1 1/2" x 20 1/2" for top and bottom border 1
- 2 strips 1 1/2" x 28 1/2" for side border 3
- 2 strips 1 1/2" x 30 1/2" for top and bottom border 3
- 2 strips 2 1/2" x 53" for side border 5
- 2 strips 2 1/2" x 57" for top and bottom border 5
- 7 strips 2 1/4" x width of fabric for binding

**Light Aqua Print (1 1/4 yards\*)**

- 8 squares 5 7/8" x 5 7/8" cut in half diagonally to make  
16 triangles (A)
- 6 squares 11 1/4" x 11 1/4" cut in half diagonally twice to make  
24 triangles (B)

1. Trim center block to 18 1/2" x 18 1/2". Join dark aqua 18 1/2" strips to the sides. Sew dark aqua 20 1/2" strips to the top and bottom.
2. Join 5 pieced blocks (4" finished) together. Make 2 and sew to the sides of the quilt center. Join 7 pieced blocks together. Make 2 and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt center.
3. Sew dark aqua 28 1/2" strips to the sides. Join dark aqua 30 1/2" strips to the top and bottom.
4. Trim small blocks to 7 1/2" x 7 1/2".
5. Sew together 3 small blocks, 4 light aqua A triangles, and 4 light aqua B triangles to make 2 side pieced borders as shown. Join to the sides of the quilt center.
6. Sew together 5 small blocks, 4 light aqua A triangles, and 8 light aqua B triangles to make top and bottom pieced borders. Join to top and bottom of the quilt center.
7. Measure the quilt center from top to bottom and trim the dark aqua 53" strips to this length. Join to the sides of the quilt center.
8. Measure the quilt center from side to side and trim the light aqua 57" strips to this length. Join to the top and bottom of the quilt center.
9. Layer, baste, and quilt. Bind with dark aqua fabric.

**\*Yardage does NOT include fabric for the pieced blocks.**
